Parents/carers of Year 6 children living in Nottingham City must apply for a Secondary school place online or on Nottingham City Council's common application form by 31st October 2025

If you apply for your child's school place online, you will receive an email on **3rd March 2026**. If you applied via post, you will be notified by letter posted second class on/around **3rd March 2026**.
**** Please note- you should confirm to the local authority whether or not they wish to accept the place offered within 14 days of receipt of their offer. Failure to do so may result in the place being withdrawn.**

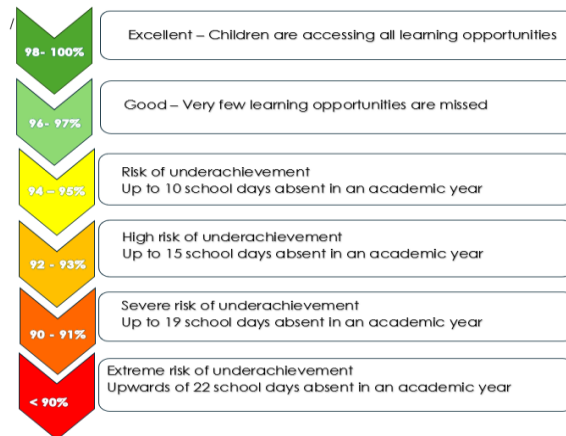
