Five Fabulous Facts about Europe.

I know that Europe is made up of countries and capital cities which have different physical and human features that are unique to the country and landscape.

I know that Europe is the second-smallest continent, but the third-largest in population

I know that the UK imports goods such as cars and medicines and exports goods such as gas turbines, cars and some pharmaceutical things.

I know that migration means the movement from one place to another and that there are *different types of migration including forced and voluntary, temporary and permanent and economic*

I know that Krakow is located in Southern Poland and the climate that they experience is usually cold winters and warm summers.

Vocabulary

Continent -any of the world's main continuous expanses of land (Europe, Asia, Africa, North and South America, Australia, Antarctica)

Trade-*the action of buying and selling goods and services*

Import- bring (goods or services) into a country from abroad for sale.

Export-send (goods or services) to another country for sale

Migration - the movement of people from one place to another

Climate - weather conditions prevailing in an area in general or over a long period.

Physical feature-features that exist naturally and would be present even without human intervention

Human feature- Human features are **things like houses, roads and bridges**. They have been built by people
