## Ramadan 2025

As you may be aware Ramadan begins around 1<sup>st</sup> March this year and is expected to conclude (depending on the full moon) on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> March, meaning Eid-al-Fitr is likely to fall on Monday 31<sup>st</sup> March.

We recognise that the holy month is an extremely important time for many of our children and families and understand that as a commitment to this pillar of Islam children may want to partake in fasting during the day.

Children who are observing the fast will not take part in PE, swimming or after school activities.

Due to health and safety reasons, we would encourage pupils to break their fast if it is a risk to their health and wellbeing. For example feeling dizzy, faint or vomiting.

Children will not be able to fast without parental consent.
