We know that you share these aims and, in helping us to achieve them, we ask you to respect the guidelines overleaf.

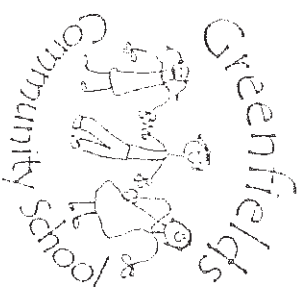
Parents are always warmly welcome in school.
